The unique technology preserves the colors of your images and protects your prints from outdoor damages such as dirt, water and UV rays. Ideal for protecting wide format inkjet prints on water resistant media printed with pigmented or solvent inks. Great for signage, vehicle graphics, banners, fine art reprints on water resistant canvas. The EZglide works best when used with either semi-gloss or low gloss substrates in order to properly enhance the color of the ink. The Daige EZglide Liquid Laminator is the ideal imaging tool for virtually anyone.

Step 3. Put the coating rod down, and the media is submerged in the laminate. Pull the image through and you receive a perfect coating on the image, while the print stays completely dry.

Step 4. When finished coating, drain the coating and wipe down the coating rod and tray. It is that easy!

This innovative system rolls a liquid coating onto a print without the mess of spraying, brushing or hand rolling. Ideal for vinyls, banners and waterproof media, the EZglide is perfect for any professional who is looking for a high-quality but cost-efficient tool that will help them preserve and protect their outdoor media.

Ideal Applications

The Daige EZglide Liquid Laminator is the perfect digital imaging tool for outdoor signage, billboards, vinyl banners, trade show displays, vehicle graphics and promotional graphics.

Product Positioning

The Daige EZglide is ideal for anyone who would like long-term conservation of their outdoor prints. For indoor work, it is better to use the Quickmount III, a low cost cold laminator and pressure mouter. The reason for this is indoor substrates are not waterproof and have high gloss coatings that sometimes cause dye ink to smear—this is not the case with outdoor, waterproof substrates. Competitively priced, the Daige EZglide is ideal for anyone who wants to reduce their finishing costs while maintaining efficient graphic production.

Competition

The primary competitor of the Daige EZglide Liquid Laminator is Hunt Corporation’s AquaSEAL AS 1600 and SW3000. Though aimed at similar markets as the EZglide, the AquaSEAL is a much different type of machine. The AquaSEAL, a roll-fed unit, operates in a roll-to-roll format that accommodates both roll and sheet substrates. Much higher priced than the EZglide, the AquaSEAL applies coating in a different manner and has much higher weight requirements. The EZglide, however, accommodates sheet substrates only so it does not have to support huge rolls of media. Since higher cost products like the AquaSEAL must have roll capabilities, it is difficult for them to coat a sheet of media efficiently. The EZglide’s strategic advantage is superior protection of sheet substrates at a much lower cost than other liquid laminators.

FAQs

Q: How easy is the EZglide to use?

A: All you have to do is pour the coating into the refill tray and insert the image and pull through. The entire process takes only a minute to set up, seconds to coat and less than five minutes to clean.

Q: What type of coating is used with the EZglide?

A: We recommend using a non-hazardous water based coating like GO Liquid Shield. This coating is perfectly suited for the outdoor protection of images printed on vinyls, banners, semi-gloss and low-gloss substrates and other waterproof materials. Not all water based coatings, however, are compatible with the EZglide. You should consult Graphics One or Daige to determine if your coating will work properly in the EZglide.

Q: Is it possible to apply more than one coating for additional protection?

A: For those desiring increased protection, we recommend an additional pass through the EZglide.

Q: Do you have to use the recommended coating?

A: It is highly recommended that you use GO Liquid Shield or the Daige EZglide coating. The coating viscosity has been formulated to work specifically with the EZglide for easy clean-up and efficiency.

Q: How long does the image take to dry?

A: Drying time varies according to the number of coats on the image (some may opt to add a second coat for additional protection). It normally takes about ten to fifteen minutes for the coating to dry and eight hours to fully cure.

Q: What maintenance is required with the EZglide?

A: When finished using the EZglide for the day, it is necessary to drain the coating and wipe down the coating rod and tray. The whole clean-up process takes five minutes.

Q: How long will the image last without any degradation?

A: Since there are many different ink and media combinations, it is difficult to provide a blanket statement. Based on extensive testing, the EZglide can be expected to double the life of the ink and media, for up to one year of protection.
