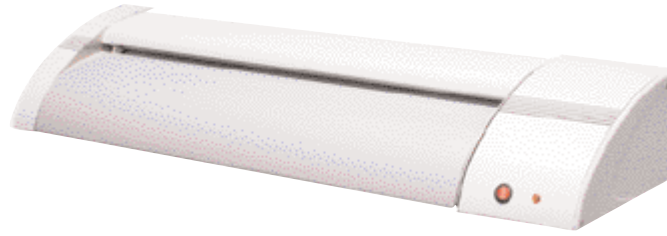

Step 2. Remove the media and position it as you like. Reposition as needed.

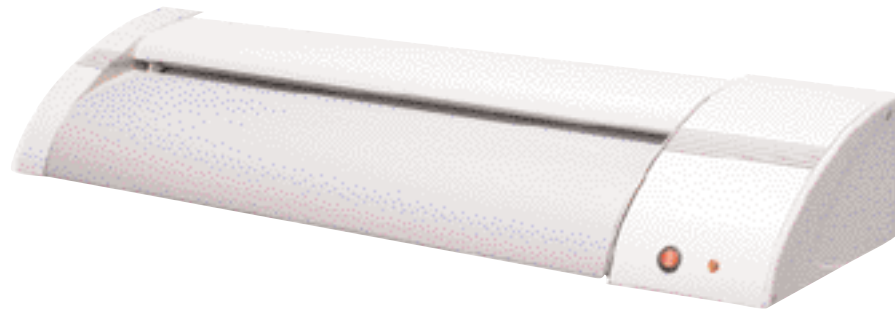
Step 3. When satisfied with positioning, roll down the media. The bond is permanent and will not be affected by heat or humidity! It is that simple!

Competition

To the best of our knowledge, the Daige Maxit is the only automatic adhesive applicator available in the market today. The primary competition of the Maxit includes various manually applied adhesives, however, since the Maxit is such a unique, one-of-a-kind machine, this competition is indirect. The Maxit's strategic advantage is that it provides an easier, faster, cleaner and less expensive alternative to adhesive cartridges, rolls, and double sided films.

FAQ's

Q: How easy is the Maxit to use?

A: Very easy. The coater is fully automatic and warms up in twenty to thirty minutes. All a user has to do is turn on the motor and insert their media into the rollers. The microthin adhesive coating is rolled on in seconds.

Q: What kind of adhesive is used with the Maxit?

A: The Maxit is used with easy to refill adhesive bars that melt in the adhesive tray. The waterproof adhesive features a melting point of 180 degrees Fahrenheit (82 degrees Celsius) and will adhere to most any surface. It can be used with a wide range of media and possesses numerous safety features including being nontoxic, nonflammable and odor free.

Q: How long after the initial coating is applied does the adhesive dry out?

A: The pressure sensitive adhesive is dry to the touch, but it will not dry out until it achieves a permanent bond from being rolled down. This allows the user to reposition the media as often as they like without compromising the adhesion.

Q: What options are available when purchasing the Maxit?

A: The Maxit is available with coating widths of either 12" (30.5 cm), 24" (61 cm), 36" (91.5 cm) or 55" (139.7 cm). The Maxit is also available with electrical compatibility of either 110 or 220 volts.

Q: How secure is the adhesion?

A: The Maxit adhesive ensures a very strong bond that will not be affected by heat or humidity. For mounting prints that are 22" x 28" (56 cm x 71 cm) and larger, we recommend reinforcing the Maxit adhesive with the Daige Quickmount II, a low cost pressure mounter and cold laminator.

Q: What maintenance is required with the Maxit?

A: None. The Maxit requires no regular maintenance or cleaning.
