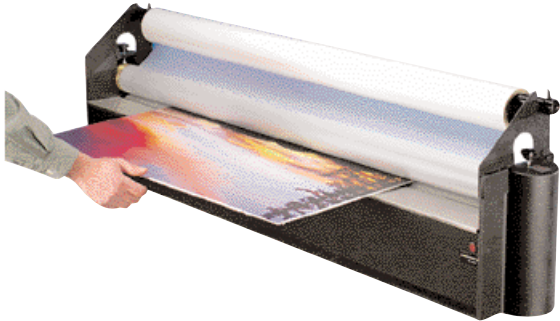

As a laminator, the Quickmount II is ideal for indoor prints as it protects against discoloration and smears. For mounting, the Quickmount II makes a great companion to the Rollacote and Maxit adhesive systems, as well as other adhesive systems, as it quickly and easily applies pressure and enforces the adhesive with a smooth, clean finish. Compatible with virtually any mounting materials, the Quickmount II is ideal for anyone who wants to protect and preserve the quality of their prints.

Who needs Daige Quickmount II to use?

Daige Quickmount II is the perfect tool for anyone who needs a quick and easy way to mount and laminate indoor media. This unique two-in-one machine automatically rolls down adhesive backed materials to boards and substrates, as well as automatically applies cold laminates and transfer tapes to substrates with high gloss coatings.

How easy is Daige Quickmount II to use?

For mounting:

Step 1. Attach your printed image with adhesive.

Step 2. Insert printed image into the Quickmount II.

The machine will apply pressure to your material, securely and evenly mounting the media.

For cold Laminating:

Step 1. Attach the roll holder to the Quickmount II.

Step 2. Insert the media into the Quickmount II.

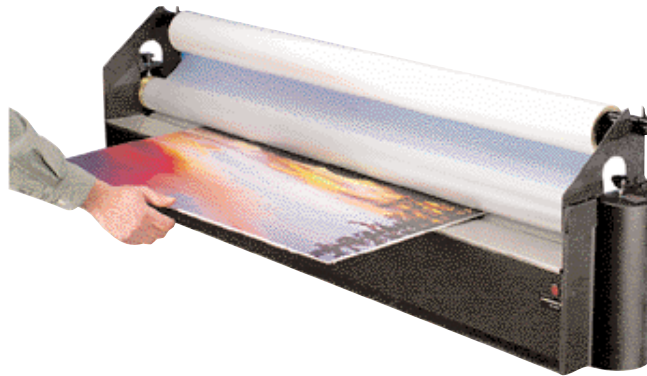
Step 3. Let the media pull through the Quickmount II for laminating.

If your customers do extensive outdoor work, it is recommended that they use the Rollacote, a low cost liquid laminator that is better suited for low-gloss and semi-gloss waterproof substrates.

Competition

The primary competitor of the Daige Quickmount II is the ProSEAL, a cold pouch laminator and pressure mounter. Though the two machines are meant for similar applications, the ability of the ProSEAL to adhere to those applications is contingent upon the amount of additional materials purchased by the customer. Using the ProSEAL, the customer must purchase separate pouches and pouch boards to accommodate each application, thus making the ProSEAL a very costly system. The Quickmount II, however, can accommodate a wide variety of applications without the hassle and expense of purchasing additional materials. The Quickmount II's strategic advantage is that it is an easy-to-operate high quality machine that is much more affordable than other systems.

FAQs

Q: How easy is the Quickmount II to use?

A: All a user has to do is attach their printed image with adhesive and insert it into the Quickmount II. The machine will automatically apply pressure to the material, securely and evenly mounting the media. For cold laminating, simply attach the optional roll holder, insert the media and allow it to pull through the Quickmount II. To apply transfer tape, place the roll of tape on the roll holder and the Quickmount II will automatically apply the tape to the media.

Q: What type of laminate is used with the Quickmount II?

A: The Quickmount II is compatible with most pressure-sensitive adhesive laminates, like GO Film Shield. This laminate is perfectly suited to protect and preserve images printed on a wide variety of media. Since the Quickmount II is not a thermal laminator, however, thermal laminates are not compatible with the Quickmount II.

Q: What kinds of ink and media are compatible with the Quickmount II?

A: For cold lamination, virtually any kind of ink or media is compatible with the Quickmount II. For mounting, most any board can be used with a maximum thickness of 1/2" (12.7mm).

Q: What options are available when purchasing the Quickmount II?

A: The Quickmount II is available in three different sizes. The 25" (63.5 cm) Quickmount II comes with outside dimensions of 9.5" x 32" x 12" (24.1 cm x 81.3 cm x 30.5 cm) and a roller width of 25" (63.5 cm). The 38" (96.5 cm) Quickmount II comes with outside dimensions of 9.5" x 45" x 12" (24.1 cm x 114.3 cm x 30.5 cm) and a roller width of 38" (96.5 cm). The 55" (139.7 cm) Quickmount II comes with outside dimensions of 9.5" x 62" x 12" (24.1 cm x 157.5 cm x 30.5 cm) and a roller width of 55" (139.7 cm). The Quickmount II is also available with electrical compatibility of either 110 or 230 volts. Further, the Quickmount II can be purchased with or without the optional roll holder attachment for applying cold laminates and transfer tapes.

Q: How long will the image last without any degradation?

A: Due to the varying amounts of UV inhibitors in pressure-sensitive adhesive laminates, it is difficult to provide a blanket statement. Based on extensive testing, the Quickmount II can be expected to double the life of the image when used with GO Film Shield, or other similar film laminates.
